A broad artistic spectrum is required as well as knowledge and promotion of piano chamber music, instrumental accompanying and Lied interpretation.

Mainz School of Music expects its professorial staff to actively participate in academic self-administration and to engage in developing and adapting its courses of study and study programs.

Requirements:

- Personality with a proven record of several years of successful international concert activity
- Extensive repertoire of all stylistic periods including contemporary music
- Completion of a university degree (master's or diploma, concert exam desired) in piano performance
- Several years of successful teaching experience at music colleges or comparable international institutions
- Particular aptitude for artistic-musical work
- In addition to the general requirements according to public services law, applicants must meet the recruitment requirements stipulated in Section 49 of the Hochschulgesetz of Rhineland-Palatinate.
